




ARRANGEMENTS FOR WORK PLACEMENT

We constantly offer webinars from experts and key players of the industries to improve their employabilities and develop their soft skills capabilities.








46% of alumni obtained a salary increase after graduating

POPULAR EMPLOYABILITY SKILLS IN DEMAND BY EMPLOYERS




